# Who are we ?

We are a Pet Cat Club, set up especially for the owners and lovers of non-pedigree pet cats or "moggies". We were founded in September 1994, during National Cat Week and have grown rapidly ever since. We are a friendly club, offering help and advise wherever possible and we also like to meet each new member individually.

Whilst we set up initially as a "Show Club", i.e. encouraging and offering advise on the fascinating hobby of showing pet cats at Championship and other cat shows, we also have a strong interest in cat welfare. Our welfare side expanded to the degree that we set up the SRPCC Cat Welfare Trust, which gained Registered Charity status in October 1995.

We hold an annual Pet Cat Show in February of each year, with our first show taking place only five months after our formation! The show is solely for non-pedigree cats and kittens and the event is always well attended, we believe because of the wonderful rosettes and trophies that are up for grabs. We believe in the moggy being King (or Queen) for the day and our aim's to provide quality rewards for the non-pedigrees in their own show.



Our founder members show their own cats in shows throughout the North and North West of England and we are always available to offer help and advise to members and non-members alike in the showing of non-pedigree cats.

We encourage this activity as an enjoyable, competitive, yet friendly hobby that offers the opportunity to have a fun day out and often make new friends. We always emphasise, however, that showing is meant to be fun, both for the owner and for the cat and we would not recommend the continued showing of a cat who is quite clearly distressed by the whole thing. However, it is often amazing how often a much loved family pet takes to the show scene, even in many cases ending up at the feline equivalent of Crufts, "The Supreme Cat Show".

Our founders and committee members are often to be seen at various cat shows and local events with the SRPCC stall, selling a wide range of new and handmade goods to raise funds for the Trust's welfare activities. The funds assist with the payments of up to 50% of the costs incurred in respect of emergency or essential but unexpected veterinary treatment for local cat owners in receipt of State Benefit. We also carry out whatever other welfare activities we have the funds and facilities for.

In pursuance of our general welfare aims we also work closely with other local cat and animal welfare organisation. A regular newsletter keeps Club members amused and up to date with are welfare activities whilst an annual report is sent to those members who are Trust members only.
